Arm Stay	STAY for 2 seconds
Arm Away	AWAY for 2 seconds
Turn Chime On/Off	CHIME for 2 seconds OR [Access Code] + * 4
Reset Smoke Detectors	RESET for 2 seconds OR * 7 2
Quick Arm/Exit	EXIT for 2 seconds OR * 0
Disarm the system	Enter your 4 digit access code
Night Arm	(When armed in Stay Mode) * 1
No-Entry Arming	(When armed) * 9
Duress Code	4 4 4 4 for a silent panic alarm (Unless your duress code has been changed)
Bypass Zones	* 1 [3 Digit Zone Number]
Set Date & Time	* 6 [Master Code] + 0 1 + [New Date/Time] * *
Add User / Change User Code	* 5 + [Master Code] + > [Select User] * * [Enter Code] # #
View Troubles	* 2 + < >
View Alarms	* 3 + < >
Delete User	* 5 + [Master Code] + [Select User] * * * # #
User Settings	* 6 + [Access Code] + > (Bright Control and Buzzer Control)

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

In case of...	What to do...	What happens...
Accidental Alarm Activation	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Enter your access code 2. Wait for the Monitoring Response Center to call you 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alarm will sound until a valid access code is entered 2. Give the dispatcher your password
Fire Alarm	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Leave immediately. If you are already outside DO NOT re-enter the building 2. Follow your fire evacuation plan 3. Call 911 or fire department from a safe distance as an extra precaution 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alarm will sound 2. The system will automatically notify the Monitoring Response Center, who will dispatch the fire department
Burglary Alarm	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If you are already outside, DO NOT re-enter the building. 2. Call 911 or police department from a safe distance as an extra precaution 3. If you are inside the building and can leave safely, do so. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alarm will sound 2. The system will automatically notify the Monitoring Response Center, who will verify the alarm before dispatching the police
CO Alarm	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Immediately move outdoors or to an open window/door 2. Call emergency services as an extra precaution 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Alarm will sound 2. The system will automatically notify the Monitoring Response Center, who will dispatch emergency services

WHAT THE SOUND MEANS

High volume, high pitched pulsing	FIRE
Rapidly alternating high/low pitched tone	BURGLARY or TAMPERING
Beep every 8 -10 seconds	SYSTEM TROUBLE CONDITION
4 quick beeps followed by a 5 second pause	CARBON MONOXIDE PRESENT
